



Livani-Utena Cycling Cup (LUC-CUP)

Regulations

1. Tasks and objectives.

- To advance cooperation between Latvian and Lithuanian cross-border region cycling enthusiasts and professional cyclists through a creation of a cross-border network of cyclists and healthy lifestyle practitioners.
- To popularise competitive cycling and cycling for leisure as an inclusive and healthy physical activity;
- To popularise the bicycle as an environmentally friendly and safe mode of transport;
- To encourage a meaningful use of free time among children, teens and adults;
- To determine the winners and the runners-up among the participants and groups in article (4) of the given regulations.

2. Competition organisers and hosts.

Livani-Utena Cycling Cup competition is being organised by the NGO "Dviračīu akadēmija".

Livani-Utena Cycling Cup is being organised as a part of Interreg V-A Latvia – Lithuania Programme 2014-2020 cooperation project LLI-536 „Improvement of the quality of life in Latgale, Zemgale and Utena regions through a creation of a cross-border network of cyclists and healthy lifestyle practitioners (Velol)". The project is co-funded by European Regional Development Fund.

3. Location and time.

22th of May, 2022 Utena Municipality, Vaikutēnai

Children's competition start time UM14 – 11:00 girls, UV14 - 11:45 boys.

UM16 start time – 12:30 girls, UV16 – 13:15 boys.

Juniors – 14:00.

4. Participants, groups and distances.

- For the underage participants (minors) - forms have to be filled and signed by the parent/s or the legal guardian
- Any type of bike is allowed in order to participate. The bike has to be in a good technical condition. Competition forbids use of studded tires, steering wheel extensions as intended for triathlon or personal use bicycles. Common extra handlebars are allowed.
- The competition route is in circles. The length of a circle is approximately 1,5 kilometres.

Participants complete the specific distances according to the specific age groups:

6 Participation fees

Participants do not have to pay a participation fee.

7 Scores

- Point race, every second lap intermediate sprint 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th riders gets 5, 3, 2, 1 points, at the finish (10, 6, 4, 2 points). If participants score the same number of points, the winner is determined by the main finish.

8 Awards

- Award ceremony will take place after all the participants finish the race.

9 Notice to the participants!

- All the participants **must** wear a **protective helmet**. The protective helmet must be correctly fastened and worn at all times during the race part of the competition. It is forbidden to attach any hard items to the protective helmet (video cameras and so on and so forth).
- Each participant is personally liable to ensure an appropriate state of health and the eligibility for the competition of themselves or the minor in their care and is personally liable to follow the general road safety rules and the regulations of the competition as confirmed by his/her signature upon signing-up for the competition. If this assurance cannot be guaranteed, it is advised to choose the shortest possible distance among the ones provided.
- Application forms of minors have to be completed and signed by the parent/s or the legal guardian.
- Organisers and any other legal entities (human and non-human) involved in organising this competition are not responsible for any intentional, unintentional, unforeseeable or foreseeable physical and/or material losses of the participants, that take place before, during and after the competition. Organisers are not responsible for potential collisions, falls, injuries or other accidents that take place on the route during competition.
- By confirming their participation in the competition with a signature on the application form, participants refuse to make any claims towards organisers and/or any other legal entities (human and non-human) involved in organising the competition in the case of an accident or a material loss and do not attempt to take matters to court or other entity in order to recover their losses, and agree to the terms and conditions of the competition regulations.
- Participants have to familiarise themselves with the competition regulations. Failure to do so does not exempt the participants from personal liability.
- By signing-up for the competition, participant agrees to the processing of personal data for the competition purposes, in order to ensure objective competition results it is necessary to indicate participant's name, surname, sex, date of birth and the chosen distance. Other types of data can be freely provided if a participant so wishes.
- By signing-up, participants agree that photos and video materials made/recorded during the competition can be used by the organisers for various purposes, for publicity, as well as for publicity in various types of mass media, social media and so on and so forth.
- *Distance lengths are subject to change.
